

Eagle Charter School Example Student Schedule, Fall 2020

What would a day look like for my Eagle student during **Comprehensive Distance Learning**?

As we approach the start of the 2020-2021 school year, all Eagle Charter School students will start the year in a Comprehensive Distance Learning program. This model will continue until COVID-19 case numbers in the county are low enough that state guidance deems it safe enough for all students to return to in-person schooling. Currently, Eagle is scheduled to be in a distance model through November 6 and will reevaluate at the end of October to see if an extension to distance learning is necessary.

This model is a <u>draft only</u>. Parents and students will receive an updated official schedule the week of September 8 when students meet one-on-one with teachers. <u>Classes for all students begin September 14,</u> 2020.

Students will attend teacher-led/facilitated lessons covering core subjects for approximately 1-2 hours each day (Monday through Thursday), depending on grade level. In addition to teacher-facilitated lessons, students will be expected to watch teacher-created instructional videos and work on assignments independently or with a teacher for an additional 1-2 hours each day. Each day students should have 3-4 hours of learning.

Student requirements: Attend school every day by participating in online classes and submitting completed assignments to the teacher.
